



## Undergraduate Nursing Programs Admission Scoring Criteria Worksheet

The purpose of this worksheet is to provide applicants to the Nursing Program with the scoring methodology used in evaluating applications to the **LVN**, **AAS** and **Fast Track to AAS** programs of study. Please note that the requirements in this worksheet are not exhaustive and that there are additional college and program requirements that must be met by the applicant.

| <b>1. Science Courses Pre-Requisites</b><br>a. The science courses listed below should not be older than five (5) years.<br>b. Applicants need to enter the highest course score, if the course was taken more than once.<br>c. Points for course grade are assigned as follows:<br>i. "A" = 3 Points<br>ii. "B" = 2 Points<br>iii. "C" = 1 Point<br>iv. CLEP Pass Score = 1 Point (for PSYC 2301 only)  |               |           |            |

| <b>3. HESI Exam</b><br>a. Required areas: <b>1) Reading, 2) Math, 3) Grammar, 4) Vocabulary, &amp; 5) Anatomy &amp; Physiology</b><br>b. Please note HESI exam takers are allowed a maximum of three (3) attempts a year; with a minimum of 60 days between attempts.<br>c. Applicants must achieve 75% or better in each of the five subcategories.<br>d. Points for HESI <b>Total Score</b> are assigned as follows:<br>i. 75% to 80% = 1 Point<br>ii. 81% to 86% = 2 Points<br>iii. 87% to 92% = 3 Points<br>iv. 93% to 100% = 4 Points | 4             | 4         | 4          |
| <b>4. Overall Cumulative GPA</b><br>a. This is based on GPAs from all colleges/universities attended.<br>b. The acceptance committee will average the GPA from multiple sources.<br>c. Points are calculated based on the following GPA ranges:<br>i. 2.50 - 2.75 = 1 point<br>ii. 2.76 - 3.00 = 2 points<br>iii. 3.01 - 3.25 = 3 points<br>iv. 3.26 - 3.50 = 4 points<br>v. 3.51 - 4.00 = 5 points  | 5             | 5         | 5          |
| <b>5. Recommendation Letters</b><br>Applicants need to provide two (2) references in the application to be contacted by TCC to obtain recommendations for the applicant. One of the two references must be a current or recent instructor, employer, or supervisor. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that the references submit their recommendation within the allotted timeframe.   | 1             | 1         | 1          |
